Based upon the information provided in your submittal received September 10, 2014, the above referenced plan is not approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

1. There is only a 4.5 inch water block on Louisiana at the entrance to the site. Reasons have been provided for doing this, but it is not acceptable to have public water enter the property without a public drainage easement which is not advisable. Provide an 8 inch water block or demonstrate the water in Louisiana is less than 4.5 inches with an analysis of the upstream drainage basin.
