Dear Mr. Montoya:

The purpose of this letter is to request a design variance which would allow a small portion of roof drainage, from Unit 5 of the referenced subdivision, to pond in the backyard of that unit. See final grading certification stamped January 20, 1996 for hydrology calculations and final as built grades.

The reason for this request results from the builder/developer's decision, during construction, to change the City approved grading of Unit 5. It was the builder/developer's idea to drain the backyard of Unit 5 across the rear yard of Unit 6 via a private drainage easement. At the time the builder owned Unit 6 and therefore did not anticipate a problem with the easement or the drainage concept. The builder sold Unit 6, however, without securing the granting of the private easement. Subsequently, the acquisition of the easement became most difficult. Therefore, it became necessary to come up with an alternative plan that would not require the easement.

The resulting plan is that shown which basically utilizes roof drains to convey roof water to a point which allows the discharge of water to the front yards. Unfortunately, a small portion of the roof (290 sf.) Could not be guttered without detrimental architectural problems. (See attached letter from architect).


After our conversation pertaining to the rain gutter system at 4232 Louisiana NE the following conclusions were made concerning the relief if drainage water from the rear or eastern yard.

- the eastern gutters should be reversed to flow water to the north, thus relieving the water to drain around the house.
- to relive drainage water from the garage roof a gutter system would have to be built across the stucco portion of the eave above the southern windows. This would be a non-acceptable solution due to the eventual destruction of the stucco at the location of the gutter and the esthetics involved from the owners standpoint.

Based upon your 4/13/94 submittal for the referenced project, I have the following comments which will need to be addressed prior to authorizing Hydrology Division approval for Final Plat, Building Permit and Grading Permit.

- 1. Private Drainage Easements will have to be granted across Lots 1 & 2 to allow for the historical offsite flows to continue across those lots. In addition, it is needed on Lot 1 to allow for the cross-lot drainage from Lot 2. As we discussed in our telephone conversation earlier today, language concerning the easements can be added to the plat.
- 2. With your resubmittal, please submit a copy of the Plat itself for our review in addition to the Grading & Drainage Plan.
