Based upon the information provided in your submittal dated 07-11-2013, the above referenced Grading and Drainage Plan is approved for Building Permit with the stipulations set forth in the ARC Letter submitted by Bohannan-Huston on April 8, 2013. These stipulations are stated as follows and will need to be included in the as-built certification:

- The northern pond needs to be increased to retain 935 CF instead of the 770 CF the plan currently reflects.
- No disturbance shall encroach onto adjacent lots. In order to minimize that the adjacent lot is not disturbed in any manner, grading shall not occur within a minimum of 24" from the property line.
