Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 01-14-2013, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- The proposed drainage concept will need to be reviewed and approved through the subdivision's architectural review committee prior to Hydrology approval being issued.
- All developed flows must be either fully retained or discharged through the drive pad to Snow Goose Court per the subdivision's DMP.
- None of the basins on the site will be accepted as being of Treatment A. Land Treatment Type B will be the minimum treatment type allowed for the flow calculations on this site.

It appears that flows from Basins B1 & B2 along with a portion of Basin B should be redirected to the southern ponding area and that this pond should be enlarged.
