

Thanks for getting back to us so quickly! I've attached our updated plans for your review.

Correct TCL parking space for restaurant is 5.6 spaces per/1000 GFA and outdoor seating is 3s pace per/1000



We are working on a Raising Cane's on the SW corner of St. Joseph's Drive and Coors Blvd NW. We are addressing our second round of building permit comments and had a question.

We received TCL Approval on 4/23/24 and have included our stamped TCL plans and approval letter in our building permit submittals. I have attached these files for reference.
