Dear Mr. Walla:

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 7-9-14, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. On the title sheet, include a design narrative summarizing the drainage scheme, describe offsite flows, and how the "first flush" will be managed. There does not appear to be a method to capture the first flush from the roof drainage or portions of the parking lot.
- 2. In the valley, discharge is limited to 2.75cfs per acre.
- 3. Provide calculations showing the 12" SD Mildred has capacity for additional discharge.

- 4. Provide waterbreaks at drivepads
- 5. Hydrology calculations show 77% Land Treatment D, but a rough estimate shows it to be more about 88% D.

6. It water harvesting or first flush is to be captured within the medians in the parking lot, indicate with keyed note and grade towards the medians.
