

MHEREAS, NIELSON ENTERPRISES INC., a Dolaware comporation, registered in the State of New Mexico ("NEI") hereby acknowledges the existence of a dispute with the CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE, New Mexico, a New Mexico municipal corporation ("CITY") regarding the design, construction, and maintenance of a drainage plan covering NEI's Sierra Vista Shopping Center, at Montgomery and Eubank Boulevards in Albuquerque, New Mexico, especially that part of shopping center expansion known as Phase II to take place on the tract described as:

Tract B-1, Plat of Sierra Vista Shopping Conter (Plat filed Soptember 22, 1978); and,

hHEREAS, the Eubank and Montgomery Land Partnership ("EMLP") desires to be a party hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the undersigned parties' mutual desire to resolve the dispute,

NEI agrees as follows:

- To construct and maintain a drainage system for the above shopping center as per the plans submitted by Tom Mann and Associates (1-005) to the CITY, May 12, 1981, and as approved by the City Engineer.
- 2. To construct and maintain existing drainage facilities and alternations to said existing facilities as mutually agreed by NEI, CITY, and EMLP.
- 3. To prepare and maintain remounable landscaping within the draining system.
 - 4. To do the above as soon as is reasonably possible.
- 5. To allow the above referenced southerly land owners (RMLP) access to the system.
- 6. The obligation of NEI set forth herein shall be binding upon NEI, its neirs, and assigns, and the property of NEI as described above and will run with said property until roleased by the CITY, such release, in recordable form, not to be unreasonably withhold by the CITY.

CITY agrees as follows:

- To issue building permits, which in all respects are proper, for shapping conver building.
- 2. To issue Occupancy Certificates for snopping content buildings
 after drainage system is substantially completed and approved by the
 City ingineer.

- 3. To condition building permits for the area immediately south of the shopping center upon the owners of such area bearing their allocable share of the drainings system construction and maintenanco.
- 4. To allow the southerly area owners (EMLP) use of the drainage system.

EMLP agrees as follows:

- 1. As owner of the property immediately south of the shopping center, more particularly described as Exhibit "A" attached herete und made a part hereof, to bear his allocable share of the above referenced drainingo system construction and maintenance.
- 2. The obligation of FMLP set forth herein shall be binding upon EMLP, their heirs, and assigns, and the property of EMLP as described shove and will run with said property until released by the CITY, such release not to be unreasonably withheld by the CITY. .
