Dear Mr. Trauernicht,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 07-13-2021, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. Provide sidewalk width around the parameter of proposed Patio.
- 2. The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 3. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code. Label pavement MC.What is the status for motorcycle parking spaces/ Explain.

All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines (What is the status? Explain:

- a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
- b. The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places. Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
- c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
- d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
- e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
- f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 4. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 5. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 6. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- 7. Show all drive aisle widths and radii. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 8. Per DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the ADA parking stall access aisles to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.

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- You cannot located ramp along side ADA access isle. This is a safety/hazard to ADA
  pedestrian traffic. Please provide a safer ramp location. So keyed note 7 will need to be
  adjusted.
- 10. Keyed note 11: for ADA the color needs to be blue.
- 11. Provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 12. Shared Site acces: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner.
- 13. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 14. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 15. Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip generation may be requested for determination (Contact Matt Grush: mgrush@cab.gov).
