

Required Mitigation:

- 1. Remove the construction and domestic waste and place in an acceptable waste container or appropriately remove from the site.
- 2. Place domestic and construction waste(s) in an acceptable container in the future.

If violations are not mitigated within 9 days, the property owner is subject to a fine of \$500/day per the City's Drainage Control Ordinance.

If you would like to schedule a follow-up inspection at a day and time of your convenience, prior to 9 days from the date of this letter please let me know. 9 days is the specified time for mitigation to coincide with the 10 days specified in yesterday's violation letter.
