- 3. Queue length:

- Provide a queuing calculations to ensure it doesn't back into the entrance and 57th Street.
- What is the total vehicular queue length of the proposed drive thru shown on site plan? Will the queue land interfer with the parking? Explain?

4. The propose Freestanding Sign will need to be locate outside of COA ROW on private property (which includes **AIRSPACE**).

- 5. Please list the width and length for all proposed parking spaces and drive aisle. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 6. ADA curb ramps must be updated to current standards and have truncated domes installed at existing entrance off 57th Street NW. If not, then provide a new design to include truncated domes.
- 7. Internal ramps:
 - Will need details for the 6ft proposed pedestrian pathway from public sidewalk across drive aisle.
 - Shown is another ramp directly onto the drive thru lane Why? This is a safety concern for any patrons. Detail for this ramp will be needed was well.
 - Do you need a ramp off ADA access aisle? Explain?
- 8. Show all drive aisle widths and radii. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 9. The minimum drive aisle dimensions are shown below

- 10. List radii for all curves shown. The minimum radius for internal is 15 ft. except the drive thru exit radius.
- 11. Per the DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details. **Dimension proposed pathway.**
- 12. Per DPM, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the ADA parking stall access aisles to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 13. All one-way drives shall have "One Way" and "Do Not Enter" signage and pavement markings. Please **show detail and location of posted signs and striping**.

14. Provide all pavement marking details of all proposed striping and pavement marking texts. This includes the striping around the parameter of the proposed drive thru lane.

15. The minimum drive through lane width is 12 feet with a 25 foot minimum radius (inside edge) for all turns. (A 15 foot radius can be used with an increase in lane width to 14 feet). Please dimension all lane widths and radii.

- 16. Keyed Note 2: Why are you proposing a 8 inch curb and gutter? when 6 inch curb and gutter is used for on site development.
- 17. Provide construction notes and details for proposed internal curbing around New building and landscaping.

Clear Sight

- 18. Please provide a sight distance exhibit
- 19. Show the clear sight triangle and add the following note to the plan: "Landscaping and signage will not interfere with clear sight requirements. Therefore, signs, walls, trees, and shrubbery between 3 and 8 feet tall (as measured from the gutter pan) will not be acceptable in the clear sight triangle.
- 20. Shared Site access: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner.
- 21. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing (2430 & 2415A).
- 22. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 23. Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic

Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip generation may be requested for determination (Contact Matt Grush: mgrush@cabq.gov).
