Thank you for the submittal received August 6, 2014 for Permanent Certificate of Occupancy. We completed a site visit and it appears that all on-site construction has been completed per your certification.

However, within a week of receiving your submittal, the city received two complaints about the traffic as a result of the project. It appears that the off-site work order has not been completed. The median modifications and signage in 12th street have not been installed and are causing dangerous conflict points for traffic flow. I have included a few pictures that show the problems.
