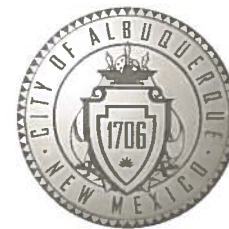

Engineer's Stamp dated 11-5-12 (H13/D057)**

Dear Mr. MacKenzie,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 11-5-12, the above referenced plans are approved for Work Order.

This project requires a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit for storm water discharge for disturbing one acre or more and a Topsoil Disturbance Permit for disturbing $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre or more. Please attach a copy of this approved plan to the construction sets prior to sign-off by Hydrology. Prior to release of SIA and Acceptance of Work Order Closeout, an Engineer Certification per the DPM checklist will be required.

Albuquerque's MS4 Permit became effective March 1st, 2012. Grading and Drainage Plans and Drainage Reports will have to comply with the requirements of the new permit (<http://www.cabq.gov/planning/landcoord/Hydrology.html>).
