SUBJECT:

ALBUQUERQUE MASTER DRAINAGE STUDY VOLUME II

Thank you for the opportunity to review the draft AMDS Volume II restudy. The source of the data used for assumptions regarding pervious and impervious surfaces and associated land-uses is not stated in the report. The Planning Department has a computerized parcel-based land-use file available that can give extremely accurate data concerning land-use and acreages. Without knowing the source of the data in the report, I can not comment on its appropriateness to the study. If the purpose of the restudy is to obtain the most accurate figures possible, you may wish to investigate the capabilities of the parcel-based data file.

Any improvements to the arroyos discussed in the adopted Facility Plan for Arroyos should consider the policies of the plan. A footnote to that effect or a footnote referencing the Facility Plan for Arroyos would be appropriate in the document. A small discussion in the text itself would also be useful where appropriate.
