

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 6/9/2025, the Grading and Drainage Plans **are not** approved for Grading Permit or Building Permit. The following comments need to be addressed for approval of the above referenced project:

Albuquerque

1. Stormwater discharges across the sidewalk are not allowed on collector roads and above; provide sidewalk culverts or drain lines through the curb for the northern outfall on Euclid Ave.

2. An SO-19 Permit will be required and should be included on the request. Please include the <u>standard SO-19</u> notes on the grading plan.

3. Please reference City of Albuquerque standard detail No. 2236 – Sidewalk Culvert with Steel Plate Top at the sidewalk culvert, if a culvert is used in the design.

As a reminder, if the project total area of disturbance (including the staging area and any work within the adjacent Right-of-Way) is 1 acre or more, then an Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) Plan and Owner's certified Notice of Intent (NOI) is required to be submitted to the Stormwater Quality Engineer (Doug Hughes, PE, jhughes@cabq.gov, 505-924-3420) 14 days prior to any earth disturbance.
