The infrastructure improvement required due to this development are as follows:

- 1. Replace all unused drive cuts and broken sidewalks with curb and gutter and sidewalk. Construct new access, sidewalk and curb and gutter in accordance with COA standards.
- 2. Close the existing northern-most access to San Mateo Blvd.
- 3. Close the existing western-most access to Menaul Blvd.
- Install a sign for right-turn existing on Menaul for motorists indicating "No Left Turn at Madeira".
- 5. The Manual Blvd. access to be restricted to right-in, right-out movements only.
- 6. The San Mateo Blvd. access to be restricted to right-in, right-out movements only
