Dear Brian;

With regard to the above referenced drainage plan and your letter dated March 17, 1983, I wish to offer the following information:

- At the request of Mr. Chuck Easterling, at the November 30, 1982 D.R.B. meeting, I reviewed the site and its potential for flood flows with Mr. Fred Aguirre. Fred was aware of flows topping the curbs at Indian School and Pennsylvania, but he did not feel that this would have any impact on the site development.
- 2. At the above referenced D.R.B. meeting it was noted that the site is totally impermeable and that ponding would not be required. However, as requested, we have routed flows through the landscaped areas. This will minimize nuisence flows from the site, provide temporary pending and reduce peak flows.

RE: OFFICE BUILDING DRAINAGE PLAN - PENNSYLVANIA AND INDIAN SCHOOL NE

Dear Vic:

I have made an initial review of the referenced project and forward the following comments:

- 1. This past summer I witnessed rather severe flooding in this area and on one occasion water was overtopping the curb in the intersection. The site is probably far enough away from the intersection that the building would not be affected. I simply pass on this observation for your evaluation in respect to the finished floor elevation.
- 2. Severe flooding takes place downstream in the vicinity of Indian School and Louisiana NE (I spent several evenings last summer replacing manhole lids in the intersection). The Drainage Ordinance does exempt parcels that have been previously developed from meeting the current requirements. Discharge from this site must be evaluated in terms of a completely developed watershed. Since problems exist downstream, detention of storm runoff is appropriate for this site.
- 3. Do the existing and proposed contours indicate that runoff will be directed to the landscaped area in the SW corner and then routed to the street through the sidewalk drain? If this is the case, then the requirement stipulated in #2 will probably be met. Please clarify this point.
 - 4. Please locate the roof drains and canales on the plan.
- 5. What provisions have been considered to insure that irrigation runoff remains out of the downstream conveyance system?



DRAINAGE FACILITIES WITHIN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY complete



NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR

- An excavation/construction permit will be required before beginning any work within City right-of-way. An approved copy of these plans must be submitted at the time of application for this permit.
- All work detailed on these plans to be performed, except as otherwise stated or provided hereon, shall be constructed in accordance with Public Works Contract No. 84-2.
- Two working days prior to any excavation, contractor must contact Line Locating Service, 765-1234, for location of existing utilities.
- 4. Prior to construction, the contractor shall excavate and verify the horizontal and vertical locations of all obstructions. Should a conflict exist, the contractor shall notify the engineer so that the conflict can be resolved with a minimum amount of delay.
- 5. Backfill compaction shall be according to ARTERIAL street use.
