Abiel/David,

It looks like a sidewalk culvert is part of the drainage plan.

Since the project has a Work Order, the sidewalk culvert should be built on the Work Order rather than by SO-19 Permit.

David,

Since the site is greater than 1 acre an approved ESC plan is to be included in the Work Order not "For Information Only".

Items to include on the ESC plan:

1. For the Utility cut in Menaul Blvd add a legend item for the excavated dirt pile and a Keyed Note that the dirt from the excavation should be piled on the uphill side of the cut and the street is to be swept when the work is complete.
2. For the waterline work. Add a legend item and keyed note that the dirt is to be stockpiled on the site.
3. It looks like the sidewalk is at the back of curb. Add a keyed note to sweep the street if dirt is present in Menaul Blvd.

Why don't you name the project Azar-Menaul Townhomes rather than 11910 Menaul Blvd NE on the Work Order plans?
