Carlos,

I have performed a site visit to the above referenced project to verify the scope of work, progress of work, and hydrologic concerns regarding the repaving of this parking lot. The shopping center has been on this original site for about 25 years. The site typically drains runoff to public facilities on Coors Blvd. in recent years the asphalt paving has deteriorated in the parking lot and the Owner, Mr. Pete Daskalos, has undertaken this project to rectify the poor paving condition. Mr. Daskalos did not realize he needed a Grading and Drainage Plan approved by the City of Albuquerque in order to perform this work. He ahs currently removed all of the asphalt driving and parking surfaces and his Contractor is regrading the lot to place new asphalt paving. In order to expedite the work and properly document the work done, Mr. Daskalos has asked Walla Engineering, Ltd. to review the site prior to paving as well as review the drainage conditions of the site. We have walked the site and will work with the Contractor prior to completion of construction in order to verify that the final constructed product will comply with COA Hydrology requirements for proper grading and drainage.

I have found that the existing grading of the parking lot provides a positive slope from the building to Coors Blvd. at a slope greater than 1%. Existing concrete drivepads provide a water block of almost 1'-0" and sidewalks and curbs are in good condition. No offsite runoff enters this parking lot, nor does the drainage from this lot flow onto other properties prior to draining to Coors.

I request that you regard this letter as grounds for continuing the repaving project at Glenrio Shopping Center with the understanding that I will prepare and submit to you an As-Built Grading and Drainage Plan once the project is complete. This will also serve as an Engineer's Certification of the site.


