Dear Mr. Casares,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 07-26-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. There are 3 different tables that show different number of required/provided parking spaces. Please verify the correct one.
- Parking spaces cannot be bisected by lot lines.
- 3. A replat is required for this property. The property is devided into 9 lots which should be 1 lot.
- 4. The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 5. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
 - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
 - The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places. Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
 - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
 - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
 - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
 - f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 6. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 7. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 8. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.

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- 9. provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 10. Unused curb cuts must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter. A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 11. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.

- a. The Traffic Circulation Layout
- b. A Drainage Transportation Information Sheet (DTIS)
- c. Send an electronic copy of your submittal to PLNDRS@cabq.gov.
- d. The \$75 re-submittal fee.
