Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 12-23-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. Please list the width and length for all existing and proposed parking spaces. Some dimensions are not shown.
- The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 3. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 4. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
 - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
 - b. The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places. Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
 - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
 - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
 - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
 - Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 5. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 6. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 7. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.

- 8. Per the IDO, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please clearly show this pathway and provide details.
- 9. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall
- 10. Please add a note on the plan stating "All improvements located in the Right of Way must be included on the work order."
- 11. Unused curb cuts must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter. A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 12. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.

- 2. A Drainage Transportation Information Sheet (DTIS)

- 4. The \$75 re-submittal fee.
