Overall the site looked pretty good with the following exceptions:

1. 25 feet of silt fence needs repair on Summer Ave.
2. The construction entrance was moved away from the curb cut, so dirt is being used as a ramp.
3. I couldn't find the required posting board per the Construction General Permit.

I visited the job trailer and hung out for a little while.

I would like to schedule a meeting next week to go through your SWPPP and see that the above exceptions have been remedied.
