Dear Mr. Duran,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 05-23-2022 and field inspection (05-25/2022), the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- Does the car wash provide restroom facilities to public? If so, then an accessible access should be provided from the ADA parking stall aisle.
- 2. **Lomas/Manzano corner ramp:** It appears that the ramp lip is not ADA accessible. Please address this concern.
- The proposed sidewalk connection coming off Lomas needs to be dimensioned.
- 4. Manzano Exit driveway Entrance:
 - The northern segment of proposed ramp is encroaching into 622 Manzano landowner frontage. You will need permission from landowner to have this work accomplished within his frontage property.
 - Add Keyed Note 6 (STOP sign).
- 5. **Keyed Note 5 (Manzano):** Need to be placed on both sides of exit driveway.
- 6. Keyed Note 14:
 - You will need to provide a segment of <u>concrete</u> sidewalk on Manzano frontage since asphalt is existing in place of concrete.
 - Reference COA std dwg 2430 for concrete sidewalk work.
- 7. Keyed Note 21: Add the text curb & gutter to statement on curb cut closure.
- 8. Proposed Refuse driveway (Manzano frontage):
 - Please provide a symbol for the proposed 6 ft valley gutter as shown on entrance driveway off Lomas.
 - Provide the frontage width of proposed driveway (not shown).
- 9. **ADA parking stall:** It appears that vehicle backing out might be a concern with queue storage lane. Explain is this a problem or not?

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10. Motorcycle parking stall:

- Why don't you provide a parallel stall to avoid any traffic situations.
- MC text will need a detail.
- 11. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall not back into the public right of way. Please explain the strategy on backing into the street causing a traffic safety concern.
- 12. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing (2430 & 2415A)- this segment of note will need to be added to General Note 5.
- 13. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 14. STATUS? EXPLAIN-Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip generation may be requested for determination (Contact Matt Grush: mgrush@cabq.gov).
