COMMENCING at the northwest corner of said Lot 47-P1, being a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Twilight Vista Lane SW; THENCE S64°55'22"E, 20.30 feet to the northwest corner of said pad and POINT OF BEGINNING; RUNNING THENCE S81°15'25"E, 69.32 feet to the northeast corner of said pad; THENCE S10°47'36"W, 37.15 feet to the southeast corner of said pad; THENCE N80°21'13"W, 67.79 feet to the southwest corner of said pad; THENCE N08°24'35"E, 36.06 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

FILL RECOMMENDATION (This Additional Consideration applies to the preceding 1 Property.)

The minimum NFIP criteria for removal of the subject area based on fill have been met for this request and the community in which the property is located has certified that the area and any subsequent structure(s) built on the filled area are reasonably safe from flooding.
