Just to follow up on our phone conversation and be sure we are on the same page, my understanding is that

in your next submittal you will be providing supplemental information which will include:

- Existing topo that shows the ponds for the previous building

- Expansion of the narrative to state how the drainage scheme was determined. Specifically, to acknowledge that there is an existing SD system, but the inlets are not close enough to the site, nor is the capacity known. State that you spoke with Ray Johnson (Facility Manager?) and the outcome of that discussion. This is needed since there is no Master Drainage plan for the zoo and so we are trying to follow the rational.

Additionally, the Building Permit process will be complicated if the retaining walls are shown partially on the architectural plans, and partially on the Civil plans. It would be better to show all retaining walls on the Civil plans.
