Dear Mr. Marroquin,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal 06-12-2020, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. The traffic circulation layout must be stamped, signed, and <u>dated</u> by an engineer or architect licensed in the state of New Mexico on all TCL sheets.
- 2. Any private structures that are located within public right-of-way such as fences, curbing and curbs, parking bumpers, roof line flag poles (includes air space), parking stalls, signs, and walls shall either be reoved or else a revocable permit with the City is required in which an annual fee is paid per year, based on squared footage of the encroachment. This will be a condition of Final/Permanent CO approval to have the Revocable Permit approved and in place.
- 3. The dimension for 60 degree angle parking are as follows: stall length=22.9ft, stall width 9.8ft, stall depth=19.8ft (adjust proposed stalls to these dimensions). Have you adjusted these dimensions to the parking stalls? The 22.9 ft stall length is to the centerline of stall.
- 4. Per the IDO, a 6 ft. wide ADA accessible pedestrian pathway is required from the public sidewalk to the building entrances. Please <u>clearly show</u> this pathway and provide details. The pathway will need to be striped across drive aisle in front of building (Porte Cochere).
- 5. All one-way drives and at end of <u>DRIVE AISLE</u> shall have "One Way" and "Do Not Enter" signage <u>(separate signage for each)</u> and pavement markings. Please show detail and location of posted signs and striping. They signage and pavement markings will need to be located on private property. On your detail sheet 2/AC-101, you show a combined signage of 'One Way" and "Do Not Enter", how was this signage determined and is it a regulatory sign from MUTCD? Was it obtained from the MUTCD guide? If not, then you will need to provide signage from MUTCD guide.
