

Engineer's Stamp dated 2-6-12 (K14/D104)

Dear Mr. Valdez,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 2-17-12, the above referenced plan can not be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed.

- The Qp must be kept at or below the historic value.
- Depress all landscape areas to retain all moisture which falls on them. Route the runoff from the parking lot through the landscape areas via curb openings.
- Provide volume calculations as well as pond volume calculations.
- Per the DPM Chapter 22 Section 9, runoff from the trash enclosure pad is required to drain to the sanitary sewer via a grease trap.
- A separate permit is required for construction within City R/W (SO 19). A copy of this approval letter must be on hand when applying for the excavation permit. To obtain a temporary or permanent CO the sidewalk culvert must be inspected and accepted.

Prior to Certificate of Occupancy release, Engineer Certification per the DPM checklist will be required.
