Per our meeting regarding First Flush requirement for the Railyards in Barelas, it is understood that several existing building are intended to be re-roofed, and there may be some site improvements as well. Because the buildings themselves are existing impervious areas, they are not subject to the first flush requirements stated in the drainage ordinance.

However, any disturbed areas of the site itself will need to meet first flush requirements before discharging into the public storm drain system. This is particularly important since this site is known to have contaminants.
