Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 06-05-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- The handicap accessible spaces must include an access aisle. Van accessible aisles should be 8ft wide.
- The ADA access aisles shall have the words "NO PARKING" in capital letters, each of which shall be at least one foot high and at least two inches wide, placed at the rear of the parking space so as to be close to where an adjacent vehicle's rear tire would be placed. (66-1-4.1.B NMSA 1978)
- Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 4. Show all drive aisle widths and radii. Some dimensions are not shown.
- 5. In the existing design the parking space is in front of the drive way. Change the configurartion of the parking in a way that parking space is not located in front of the access. Or close the existing curb-cut in 4th street and open a new curb cut in Hazeldine.
- 6. Show the location of the on-street spaces.

Resubmit a revised plan along with fully completed Drainage Transportation Information Sheet to front counter personnel for log in and evaluation by Transportation.
