Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 10-26-17, the above referenced plan is approved to be included in the SWPPP, to apply for an ESC Permit for grading and Building Permit and to be included in the Work Order construction plans with the following conditions:

1. Since the streets are steep: for the street work, mulch socks or similar should be placed at the downhill end of each block.

2. On-site slopes are approximately 5%. If the silt fence is loading- up often or gets blown-out in the southeast corner, a pond will be required.
