Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 08-24-2021, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. Alley way/Yale proposed modified entrance: You will need to provide construction notes/details for the entrance modification. Details will be needed for valley gutter transition from 6 ft valley gutter transitioning into a alley gutter. The detail will need to be provided on TCL SITE PLAN.
- 2. A detail of the proposed, Private Entrance segment of Yale, 6 ft valley gutter transitioning on the existing drivepad gutter plan will need to be provided as part of the TCL site plan process.
- 3. FD approval will need to provided as part of the TCL submittal process (Request per email dated 08-04-2021).
- 4. Alley pavement design. The pavement design need to be provided on the proposed TCL Site Plan project.
- 5. Provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 6. All one-way drives shall have "One Way" and "Do Not Enter" signage. Please show/provide detail and location of posted signs.
- 7. Shared Site access: driveways that straddle property lines, or are entirely on one propertybut are to be used by another property, shall have an access easement. Please include a copy of your shared access agreement with the adjacent property owner. This will be a Condition of Final CO approval that an approved plat be provided to Transportation Section.
- 8. Work within the public right of way requires a work order with DRC approved plans. Please provide the Work Order Number provided by DRC.
- 9. Please provide a letter of response for all comments given.
- 10. Traffic Studies: See the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) thresholds. In general, a minimum combination of 100 vehicles entering and exiting in the peak hour warrants a Traffic Impact Study. Visit with Traffic Engineer for determination, and fill out a TIS Form that states whether one is warranted. In some cases, a trip
