

We enclose herewith Quitclaim deed from the City of Albuquerque to The Regents of the University of New Mexico conveying to the Regents all of the streets and alleys in Block "B" of the Campus of the University of New Mexico. This deed was recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Bernalillo County, New Mexico on November 11, 1960 in Vol. D-570, Page 485. The deed is dated November 7, 1960 and was executed pursuant to City of Albuquerque Commission Ordinance No. 1821. This deed should be kept in the permanent records of the University.

We would like to call your attention to the reservations in the deed which read as follows:

"There is hereby retained by and reserved to the City of Albuquerque, New Mexico all easements for public utilities and drainage, whether municipally owned or privately owned, which may be necessary for public use and benefit at the present time or in the future; all the right-of-way of Campus Boulevard N. E. as a drainage and utility easement; and the right of ingress and egress to said easements and right-of-way, shown on said Plat."

We believe that this completes the work connected with the vacation of Campus Boulevard and adjoining streets and alleys.

City Planning Commission minutes of August 8, 1960. Members present: Paul J. Vollmar, Robert P. Scott, Mrs. James Brown, and Mr. Gaorge Rutherford.

V-290 Mr. Larrabes pointed out the area proposed for vacation on the air photo.

A petition was submitted to the Commission Chairman from the property owners along Campus Bivd east of Girard requesting that nothing be allowed to be built in the right-of-way which would block the drainage if the vacation is an proved. The University indicated that it had no intention to built over the drain.

Mr. Kelley pointed out to the Commission that the Traffic Board had ruled in favor of this proposal subject to the retention of easements.

The following motion was made:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT V-290 be recommended to the City Commission for approval subject to the retention of easements for existing utilities; retention of all the right-of-way of Compus Bivd as a drainage and utility cosment; and the reservation of the right-of egress and ingress for city services to the University owned properties in Block B.

Moved by Mr. Rutherford Seconded by Mrs. Brown

Motion Carried Ununimously

PLANNING DEPARTMENT COMMENTS:

The University has requested this vacation in order to consolidate its campus. No changes in the University-owned residential area along Vassar and Girard are proposed. Maintenance of the streets and alleys would become the responsibility of the University rather than the City. Campus Blvd has been closed for approximately I year, following a recommendation by the Traffic Board that the street be closed to traffic on a trial basis. Both the University and the Traffic Engineering Department are strongly opposed to Campus Blvd being open to traffic————particularly due to its awkward intersection with Lomas Blvd.

The tradit period has proven that Campus Blvd is not needed as a public street, however, several utility lines exists in the right-of-way along with a rather severa drainage problem so the entire right-of-way should be retained as a drainage and utility easement.

A petition from the property owners along Campus Blvd east of Girard has been received requesting that nothing be allowed to be built in the right-of-way which would block the drainage if the vacation is approved. The University has indicated that it has no intentions to build over the drain.

CITY COMMISSION October II, 1960 V-290

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval of V-290 is recommended. All necessary easements are provided in Section 2 of the ordinance.
