CONSTRUCTION NOTES:

 THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ABIDE BY ALL LOCAL, STATE, AND FEDERAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS WHICH APPLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS.

2. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL POTENTIAL OBSTRUCTIONS. SHOULD A CONFLICT EXIST, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER OR CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM ANOUNT OF DELAY.

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3. ALL ELECTRICAL, TELEPHONE, CABLE TV, GAS AND OTHER UTILITY LINES, CABLES AND APPURTENANCES ENCOUNTERED DURING CONSTRUCTION THAT REQUIRE RELOCATION, SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THAT UTILITY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CORDINATION OF ALL RECESSARY UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS. NO ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION MUL BE ALLOWED FOR DELAYS OR ROOMENHENCES CAUSE BY UTILITY COMPANY WORK FORCES. THE CONTRACTOR MAY BE REQUIRED TO RESCHEDULE HIS ACTIVITIES TO ALLOW UTILITY CREWS TO PERFORM THEIR PERIORED WITH.

4. DISPOSAL SITE FOR ALL EXCESS EXCAVATION MATERIAL, AND UNSUITABLE MATERIAL SHALL BE GRIAMED BY THE CONTRACTOR IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE ENVIRONMENTAL ESCULATIONS AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OBSERVER. ALL COSTS INCURRED IN OBTAINING A DISPOSAL SITE AND HALL HERETO SHALL BE CONSIDERED INCURRED IN OBTAINING A DISPORAL SHEAVEMENT OR PARMENT SHALL BE MADE. 5. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROTECTING THE EXISTING UTILITY LINES WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION AREA. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING FACILITIES CAUSED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE REPARED OR REPUACED AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE AND APPROVED BY THE CONSTRUCTION DESPENSE.

6. CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE PROPERTY AND/OR PROJECT LIMITS. ANY DAMAGE TO ADJACENT PROPERTIES RESULTING FROM THE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. ANY COSTS INCURRED FOR REPAIRS SHALL BE THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR.

 Overnicht Parking of Construction Equipment shall not obstruct driveways or Designated Traffic Lanes. The contractor shall not store any equipment or material Within the Public Right—of—way.

8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN ALL THE NECESSARY PERMITS FOR THE PROJECT PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION (I.E. BARRICADING, SURFACE DISTURBANCE).

 THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO REPLACE AT HIS EXPENSE ANY AND ALL PROPERTY CORNERS DESTROYED DURING CONSTRUCTION. ALL PROPERTY CORNERS MUST BE RESET BY A REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR.

10. ALL PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKING AND TRAFFIC SIGNING SHALL BE FURNISHED AND PLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR PER PLAN.

11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE, DMD CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION DIVISION, PRIOR TO BEGINNING ANY CONSTRUCTION WORK ON OR ADJACENT TO EXISTING STREETS.

12. ALL BARRICADES AND CONSTRUCTION SIGNING SHALL CONFORM TO APPLICABLE SECTIONS OF THE "MANUAL ON UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES" (MUTCD), U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, LATEST EDITION.

13. The Contractor shall be responsible for providing and Manitaning Construction signage until the project has been accepted by the City of Albuquerque. The contractor shall verify the proper location of all Barricading at the End and Beginning of Each Day.


14. ALL SAWCUT PAVEMENT SHALL HAVE A UNIFORM EDGE AND BE SPRAYED WITH TACK.

15. When abutting new curb and gutter to existing pavement, a 1' moe section of existing pavement adjacent to the curb and gutter shall be sawcut, removed, and replaced as per the standard specifications.

16. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENTS, PAVEMENT MARKINGS, CURB & GUITER, BONG PASS, WHEELCHAIR RAMPS, AND SIDEWALK DURING CONSTRUCTION, APART FROM THOSE SECTIONS NOLGRED FOR REMOVAL ON THE PLANS AND SHALL REPAIR OR REPLACE PER COA STANDARDS, AT HIS OWN EXPENSE.

- CONTRACTOR TO COORDINATE WITH SAD 228 CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE PM MANH TRAN (168.2791) PRIOR TO START OF

17. AN SO 19 PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO PLACE ANY MATERIAL ON OR AROUND A STORM DRAIN INLET IN THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY THAT WOULD INTERFERE WITH THE INLET RECEIVING STORM WATER PER THE ENGINEER'S DESION. CITY PERSONNEL MAY REMOVE THIS MATERIAL AT ANY TIME WITHOUT NOTICE. THE PREFERRED BMP IS TO REMOVE SEDIMENT/POLLUTANTS ON THE PROPERTY WHERE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IS OCCURRING.

18. ALL EXCAVATION, TRENCHING, AND SHORING ACTIVITIES MUST BE CARRIED-OUT IN ACCORDANCE WITH OSHA 29 CFR 1926.650 SUBPART P.




VICINITY MAP

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

- AN EXCAVATION/CONSTRUCTION PERMITS WILL BE REQUIRED BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK WITHIN THE CITY
 RIGHT-OF-WAY.
- all work detailed on these plans to be performed under contract shall, except as otherwise stated or provided for hereon, be constructed in accordance with the city of albuquerque standard specifications for public works construction, 1986 edition as revised through update #8.
- TWO WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR MUST CONTACT NEW MEXICO ONE CALL SYSTEM (260-1990) FOR LOCATION OF EXISTING UTILITIES.
- 4. PRICE TO CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXCAVATE AND VERIFY THE HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL LOCATIONS OF ALL OBSTRUCTIONS, SHOULD A CONFLICT EMIST. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER IMMEDIATELY SO THAT THE CONFLICT CAN BE RESOLVED WITH A MINIMUM AMOUNT OF DELAY.
- 5. SEVEN (7) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO BEGINNING CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION DIVISION A DETAILED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE. TWO (2) WORKING DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION ITECONISTRUCTION COORDINATION DIVISION, CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION DIVISION, CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE CONSTRUCTION COORDINATION ENGINEER (324–3400) PRIOR TO OCCUPYING AN INTERSECTION. REFER TO SECTION 19 OF THE GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS.
- 6. ALL WORK EFFECTING ARTERIAL ROADWAYS REQUIRES TWENTY-FOUR HOUR CONSTRUCTION.
- ALL STREET STRIPING ALTERED OR DESTROYED SHALL BE REPLACED WITH PLASTIC REFLECTORIZED PAVEMENT MARKING BY CONTRACTOR TO THE SAME LOCATION AS WAS EXISTING, OR AS INDICATED BY THIS PLAN SET.
- 8. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE ENGINEER NOT LESS THAN SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO STARTING WORK IN ORDER THAT THE CITY SURVEYOR MAY TAKE NECESSARY MEASURES TO INSUES THE PRESERVATION OF SURVEY MONUMENTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY SURVEYOR AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE SURVEYOR AND SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR AND BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE SURVEYOR AND SHALL NOTIFY THE CITY SURVEYOR WHO BEAR THE EXPENSE OF REPLACING ANY THAT MAY BE SURVEYOR. - CONTRACTOR SHALL RECORD DATA ON ALL UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES AS REQUIRED BY ABCINIA FOR THE PREPARATION OF "AS CONSTRUCTED" DRAWNIGS. CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT COVER UTILITY LINES AND ACCESSORIES UNTIL ALL DATA HAS BEEN RECORDED.
- 10. CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN A GRAFFITI-FREE WORK SITE. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROMPTLY REMOVE ANY GRAFFITI FROM ALL FOUIPMENT. WHETHER PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY.
- 11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE WATER AUTHORITY SEVEN (7) DAYS IN ADVANCE OF PERFORMING WORK THAT MILL AFFECT THE PUBLIC WATER OR SANITARY SEWER INFRASTRUCTURE.
