Dear Mr. Schara,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 12-12-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. A replat is required. If a replat has been done through a DRB process, please attach the approved plat.
- List the number of parking spaces required by the zoning code as well as the proposed number of parking spaces including bicycle and motorcycle parking.
- 3. Please list the width and length for compact parking spaces.
- 4. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 5. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
 - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
 - The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places.
 Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
 - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
 - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
 - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
 - f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 6. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 7. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 8. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.
- 9. Show all drive aisle widths and radii. Some dimensions are not shown.

- 10. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall not back into the public right of way.; provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 11. Show the clear sight triangle and add the following note to the plan: "Landscaping and signage will not interfere with clear sight requirements. Therefore, signs, walls, trees, and shrubbery between 3 and 8 feet tall (as measured from the gutter pan) will not be acceptable in the clear sight triangle.
- 12. Please add a note on the plan stating "All improvements located in the Right of Way must be included on the work order."
- 13. Unused curb cuts must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter. A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
- 14. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
