Dear Mr. Baker,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 11-27-2019, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. Please list the width and length for all existing and proposed parking spaces. Some dimensions are not shown.
- The ADA accessible parking sign must have the required language per 66-7-352.4C NMSA 1978 "Violators Are Subject to a Fine and/or Towing." Please call out detail and location of signs.
- 3. The ADA access aisles shall have the words "NO PARKING" in capital letters, each of which shall be at least one foot high and at least two inches wide, placed at the rear of the parking space so as to be close to where an adjacent vehicle's rear tire would be placed. (66-1-4.1.B NMSA 1978)
- 4. Motorcycle parking spaces shall be designated by its own conspicuously posted upright sign, either free-standing or wall mounted per the zoning code.
- 5. All bicycle racks shall be designed according to the following guidelines:
  - a. The rack shall be a minimum 30 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
  - The bicycle frame shall be supported horizontally at two or more places.
    Comb/toaster racks are not allowed.
  - c. The rack shall be designed to support the bicycle in an upright position. See the IDO for additional information.
  - d. The rack allows varying bicycle frame sizes and styles to be attached.
  - e. The user is not required to lift the bicycle onto the bicycle rack.
  - f. Each bicycle parking space is accessible without moving another bicycle.
- 6. Bicycle racks shall be sturdy and anchored to a concrete pad.
- 7. A 1-foot clear zone around the bicycle parking stall shall be provided.
- 8. Bicycle parking spaces shall be at least 6 feet long and 2 feet wide.

- 9. Show all drive aisle widths. Some dimensions are not shown.
- Refuse container seems to be very close to the parking space in the existing AIC parking lot. Please show distance.
- 11. Refuse vehicle maneuvering shall be contained on-site. The refuse vehicle shall not back into the public right of way.; provide a copy of refuse approval.
- 12. Show the clear sight triangle and add the following note to the plan: "Landscaping and signage will not interfere with clear sight requirements. Therefore, signs, walls, trees, and shrubbery between 3 and 8 feet tall (as measured from the gutter pan) will not be acceptable in the clear sight triangle.
- 13. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.

Once corrections are complete resubmit
