Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 10-25-12, the above referenced report can not be approved for building permit based on the following comments:

- Treatment "A" should not be used for calculating the exiting on-site and offsite runoff.
- The discharge form the site should match the exiting conditions.
- Provide ponding calculations for all the depressed landscaping areas to support the ponding requirements due to additional runoff under the proposed conditions.
- Due to its proximity to the building, we do not recommend depressing the landscaping area north of the building.
- Please avoid discharging over the sidewalk. Direct the runoff towards the right-of-way via the entrance or through the Sidewalk culverts.
