Dear Mr.Juarez-Infante,

Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 5-31-13, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. A five-foot keyway is required for deadend parking aisles.
- 2. Please list the length for all parking spaces.
- 3. List the number of parking spaces required by the zoning code as well as the proposed number of parking spaces.
- 4. Define width of the existing sidewalk.
- 5. List the width of the proposed turnouts.
- 6. List the width of the existing drivepad.
- 7. Drivepads to be removed or abandoned need to be replaced with sidewalk, curb and gutter per COA standards.
- 8. Providing a clear sight distance at cross roads for moving vehicles and pedestrian is always a concern. Recommend adding the following general note: "Landscaping and signing will not interfere with clear sight requirements. Therefore, signs, walls, trees, and shrubbery between 3 and 8 feet tall (as measured from the gutter pan) will not be acceptable in this area." Please see sight distance exhibit at street intersections for clarification in the *Development Process Manual*, Chapter 23, Part B, Section 5.a.
- 9. Please label the width of drive aisles in the parking lot and parent drop-off on the TCL, sheet C-103.
- 10. Please label new infrastructure on TCL, sheet C-103, to include sidewalks, curbs, gutters, locations of painted Fire curb, landscaping, and drivepads (include COA standard drawing number such as #2425, #2426, #2420, #2415A, #2415B for clarity if used.)

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- 11. Is there a concern with the perimeter gates swinging beyond the 90 degree open position and encroaching into parking area? Perhaps a gate stop is warranted.
- 12. There is a detail for Bollards, sheet C-505, but location of use is not identified.
- 13. There are errors between the Keynotes on sheet C-103 and associated detail sheets. Please review site plan mark-ups on file if interested.
- 14. Will the existing *DONT ENTER* sign remain at the entrance on Sunset Gardens Rd? Please clarify.
- 15. The *No Left Turn* sign, detail A1 sheet C-103, is not used within the TCL plan. Application is recommended at the egress point to Staff parking lot.
- 16. Please refer to all applicable city standards.
- 17. Please ensure all ramps are ADA compliant.
- 18. Please include two copies of the traffic circulation layout at the next submittal.
