1. An SO-19 Permit will be required and should be included on the request. Please include the standard SO-19 notes on the grading plan.

2. Stormwater discharges across the sidewalk are not allowed on collector roads and above; provide sidewalk culverts or drain lines through the curb for ponds 6, 7, and 8.
