After reviewing your drainage basin clarifications on the above referenced plan it appears the pond volume will be more than adequate to detain flows from the property.

As discussed with our staff, the rip rap emergency overflow channel can be omitted from the plan, and overflow from the backyard pond can continue to sheet flow as it did historically in the event that water were to overtop the pond. Please note this deletion on the As-Built

PO Box 1293 Grading Certification Plan.

If a future garden wall is constructed at the western edge of the ponding area, the design should include turned blocks or openings to allow for the pond to overflow as designed.
