

Good afternoon.

I went by the site today for an inspection.

Both of your track-out pads are too short. They should be about 30 feet long, most of this length to be cobble.

The material between the cobbles and the sidewalk is too small, some of it is the same size as dirt and is trackingout. This was more prevalent at the west track-out pad.

There was minor track-out onto the street along the east edge of the site. Please remove.

If you wish to have a smaller aggregate behind the sidewalk to prevent cobbles from entering the roadway(s), you could bring in some ¾" or 1" crushed aggregate.





You will have to edit it, mostly to remove my name, but you may wish to change/remove a couple other fields like "ESC File No." and "Inspection Reports".

Mostly you are looking at sediment controls (silt fence, mulch socks, inlet protection, etc...), vehicle tracking control (condition of track-out pad and whether there is track-out or not), Housekeeping/pollutant controls (e.g. trash, concrete washout, hydraulic fluid from vehicles, tipped over paint cans, etc...) and erosion controls (e.g. watering for dust, unstable slopes, erosion rills, etc...)




