Based upon the information provided in your submittal received 03-12-21, the above referenced plan cannot be approved for Building Permit until the following comments are addressed:

- 1. List the number of parking spaces required by the IDO as well as the proposed number of parking spaces including bicycle and motorcycle parking.
- 2. Please identify all existing buildings, doors, structures, sidewalks, curbs, drive pads, wall and anything that influences the parking and circulation on the site.
- 3. Identify all existing access easements and rights of way width dimensions (If applicable).
- 4. What is the status of public sidewalk on the frontage of Camino de la Sierra beyond the 24 ft entrance? You will need to provide sidewalk on the whole length of the street frontage.
 - 5. All sidewalks along streets should be placed at the property line.
 - 6. Required dimensions for low density driveways are:

- 23. Provide notes showing what work is included and on the work order and the private work on site.
- 24. Work within the public right of way requires a work order with DRC approved plans.
- 25. Please add a note on the plan stating "All improvements located in the Right of Way must be included on the work order."
- 26. Add a note stating "All broken or cracked sidewalk must be replaced with sidewalk and curb & gutter." A build note must be provided referring to the appropriate City Standard drawing.
