5	3 Your permit posting was missing or not visible from a safe, publicly accessible location. Required mitigation: CGP Part 1.5 requires you to post a notice of your permit coverage so it is visible from the public road that is nearest to the active part of construction site, and it must use a font large enough to be readily viewed from a public right-of-way.							
4	4 Your BMPs are in need of maintenance and repair. The perimeter silt fence has holes and gaps in multiple areas and the inlet protection leading to the stormwater drainage ditch needs to be repaired. Required mitigation: You must ensure all stormwater controls are maintained and remain in effective operating condition during permit coverage as per CGP Part 2.1.4.

Each operator may terminate CGP coverage only if one or more of the conditions in Part 8.2.1, 8.2.2, or 8.2.3 has occurred. After filing the NOT with the EPA, the
