Since the above referenced buildings were permitted and inspected by the residential PO Box 1293 process, Temporary Certificate of Occupancy approvals are not acceptable by the Building and Safety Division to allow people to move in. Therefore, based upon an agreement between the City and Galway Construction dated 11-22-13, Transportation will conditionally approve the buildings referenced above for Permanent Certificate of Occupancy. An accepted Engineer's certification is required to permanently approve the release of Permanent Certificate of Occupancy. In addition, an accepted Engineer's certification of all buildings in Phase 6 is required, prior to future conditional approvals of future phases.
