

Based upon the information provided in your submittal dated 1-14-11, the above referenced plan shows runoff entering Blake Rd. from a new development which is not within the City limits. The City of Albuquerque controls this section of Blake along your frontage but it becomes County R/W just to the east. The rest of Blake is actually downstream from the City section and receives the runoff from the City section. The City has no objection to the runoff entering Blake but offers the following.

• The proximity to the Amole del Norte channel creates the opportunity to put this runoff in the channel, instead of letting it run down Blake and into the valley. A storm drain connection would be allowed (not required) in order to eliminate the need for a detention pond and maybe reduce the reach and size of storm drain needed in Blake.




The City approves the drainage concept. Most of the site draining to the Amole del Norte channel with 3.5 cfs entering Blake Rd.




We are in the process of designing the above subdivision in Bernalillo County. Adjacent to the south side of the property is Blake Road which is utilized for access. The Blake Road right-of-way is located within the City of Albuquerque limits in front of this property. East of this property, Blake Road is within the Bernalillo County right-of-way all the way to Coors Boulevard. Blake Road is scheduled for improvements by Bernalillo County in the near future including a 42-inch storm drainage system that will extend from Coors west on Blake to a point just east of this property. The proposed subdivision will incorporate a retention pond into the middle of the development to be used as a park and playground facility. The pond will intercept most of the developed runoff from the site. The most southerly drainage basins will still drain to Blake road with a peak rate of about 10-cfs. This is a gross reduction from the existing 13-cfs calculated for current conditions. The proposed roadway section will easily handle the 10-cfs to drain east toward Coors Boulevard. The future County improvements will extend the proposed roadway section and will include the storm drainage system.

During our review process with Bernalillo County Public Works, Don Briggs requested that I get a letter from you concerning the City of Albuquerque right-of-way in the front of the subject property.
