SUBJECT: DELETION OF ALLEY GUTTER, NATIONAL WEATHER
 SERVICE FACILITY PARKING LOT, CITY PROJECT
 NO. 4581.90

The subject deletion was made as a cost saving measure and to eliminate un-necessary asphalt/concrete interfaces. I understand that you had required the alley gutter down the center of the parking lot to insure drainage in light of the 1/2 percent slope. My experience with similar installations has been that differential settlement at the asphalt/concrete interface can lead to worse ponding and subsequent paving problems. The user agency for this project is the Aviation Department and its representative, Jim Hinde is aware of the situation, agrees with the deletion, and affirms that the Aviation Department will not hold Public Works Hydrology responsible for any drainage problems specifically associated with the deletion of alley gutter from the parking lot.
